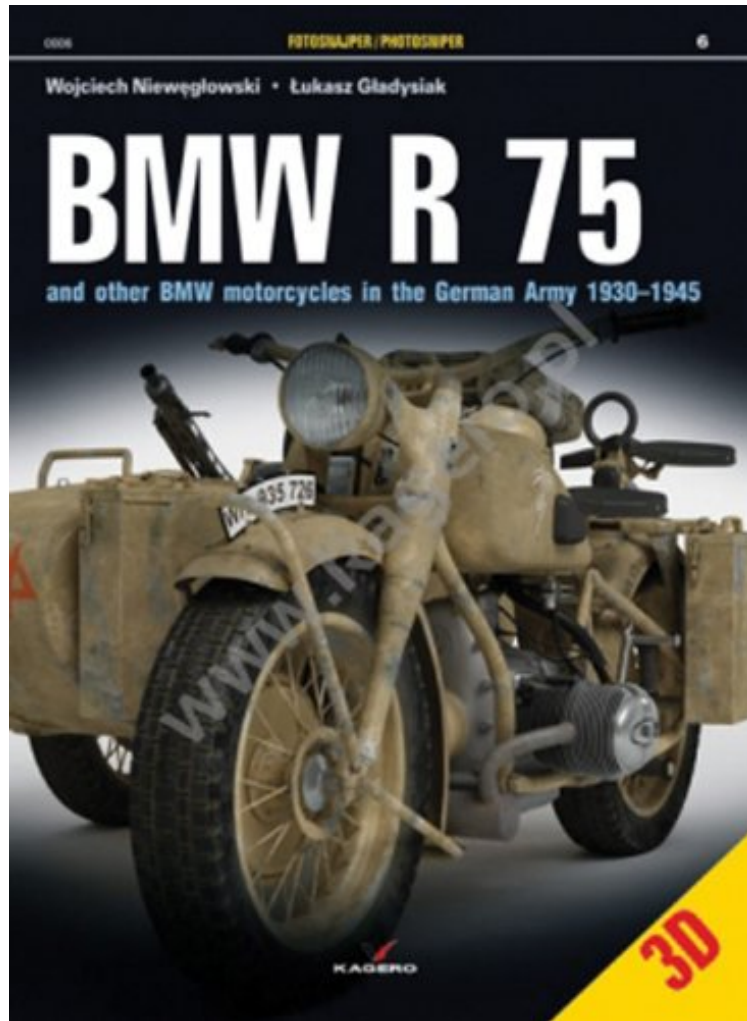

The text is a fairly pedestrian explanation of the various BMW models used by the German Army, and is readable.
