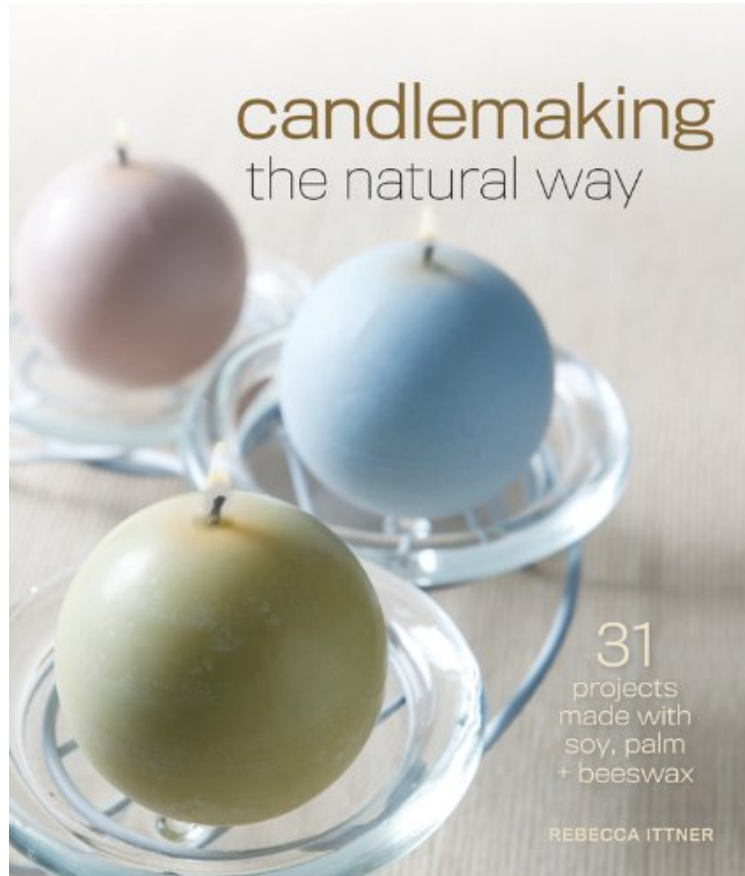

The only way this could have been better is if the projects were rated more overtly for beginner, advanced etc - ie

some of the projects later in the chronology gave step by step instructions for beginners, whereas earlier (and perhaps harder) projects' instructions assumed this knowledge. Nevertheless, I came away with great ideas and a practical knowledge of how to create candles I hadn't even imagined were possible - I have been inspired to step away from container soy candles, and branch out into the chunk pillars - I've now bought a pillar mould and palm wax as a very different direction.
