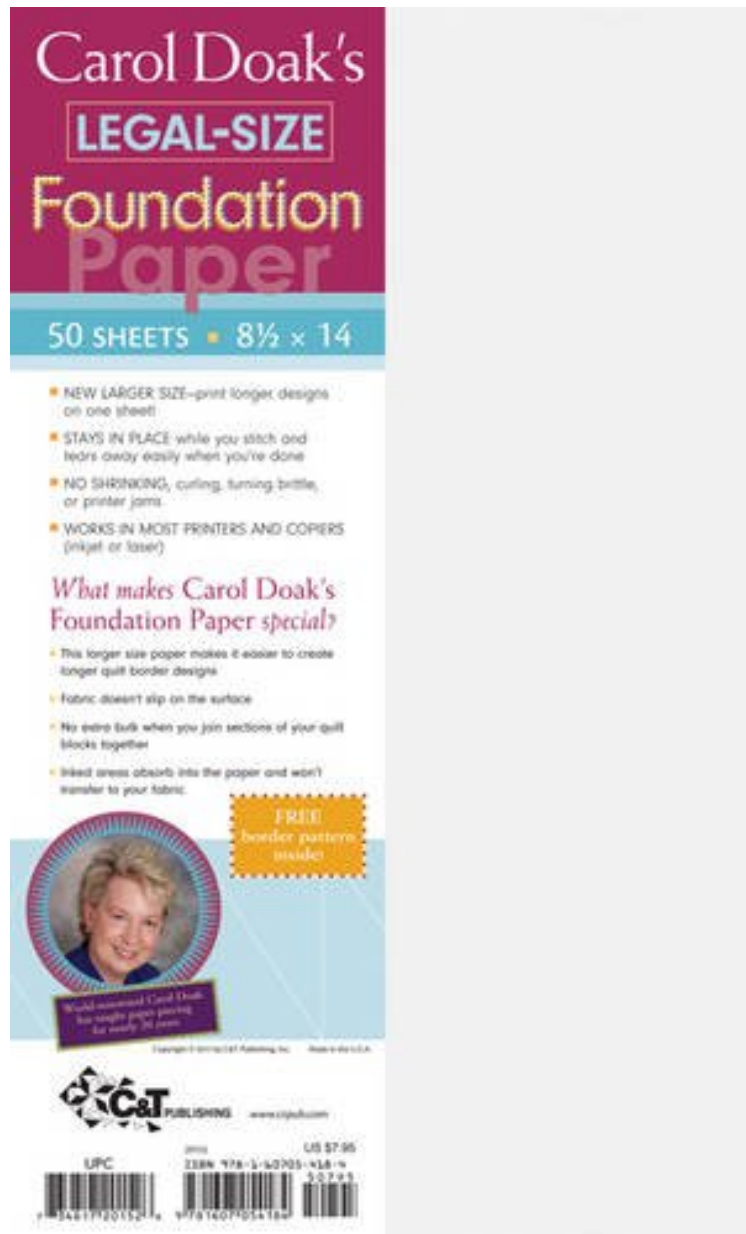

Hemphill I am just starting paper piecing, this paper works very good holds together. I was afraid it would rip easily but I have had no problems. I use removable tape if I make a mistake and have to re stitch. When it comes to removing the paper, a little stretch/pull and it is easily removed.

This new, larger size is the same great quality as the 8-1/2 x 14 sheets you know and love. Fabric doesn't slip on the surface and you won't have any extra bulk when you join sections of your blocks together. This paper is absorbent, so any inked areas won't transfer to your fabric. Now it's easier to create longer quilt border designs - a free border pattern is included in the package!
