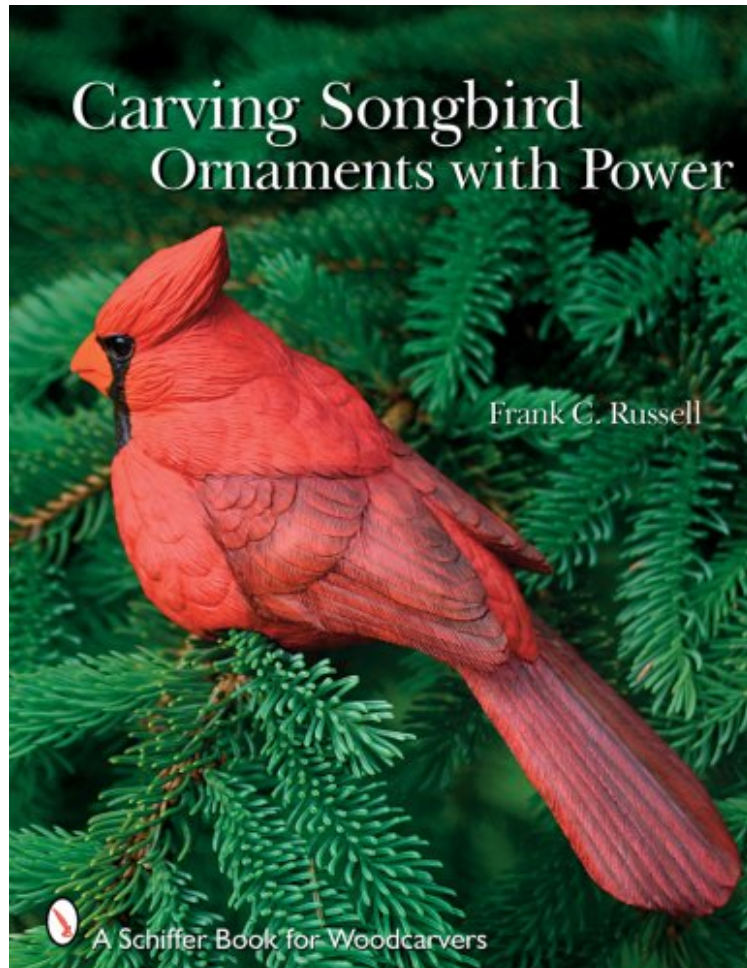

I am a beginner in wood carving and may grow to appreciate the need for these expensive tools but at this time I am using my Dremel with a flex shaft attachment and it seems to be working great. The book does a very nice job describing the different bits he uses and how they can carve the features to create the songbirds. Using this book and "Carving Realistic faces" I gained a new understanding of carving and it really helped when I started carving my butterfly. The book is designed to take you through the carving of a bird. It starts with the accessories and then wood choice. It takes you through feathers, eyes

As you can see by the cover, I do not believe the bird patterns are necessarily anatomically correct as to the exact number of feathers, etc, so if that is important to you, you might try something like the Daisey books instead.
