It starts with November, and goes through the year. It explains the holiday, traditions that went with it, and gives recipes for any foods used at that time, usually one or two recipes per holiday, although Christmas has more. There are examples of lace on almost every page, which, as a lacemaker I find most gratifying. There are probably more lacemakers in Britain than there are in the entire USA, even though England is about the size of Pennsylvania. I think British cookery is sadly underrated. While I haven't made any food from the recipes in this book, I can read them, and many of these look very good, and are written in a way that you can follow it and produce a good result.
