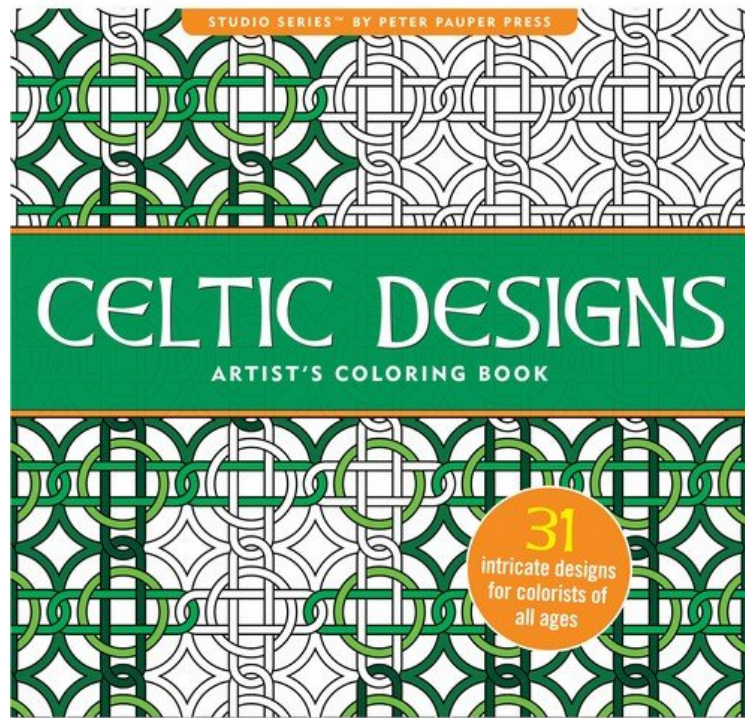

Thick One Sided Pages, Reminiscent of the Book of Kells By SLD12DAYI purchased the Celtic Designs Coloring Book because I have an interest in all things Celtic and love coloring books. This one does not disappoint with its thick paper, perforated, one-sided pages, and high quality images. Many of the mythical animal images remind me of those in the Book of Kells and the Celtic knot work is simply gorgeous. This is not one of the biggest coloring books you will find at just 31 pages. However, there is plenty of content on each page to offer much needed stress relief. There is also a wide variety of difficulty levels. From beginner to expert, it is a coloring book to start out with and to progress and hone one's skills. Nice but very repetitive...By AmyD This is a nice book, printed on good-quality paper, perforated for easy removal, and printed only on one side of the paper. As usual, I recommend that a waste sheet be used to avoid bleed-through when using markers or gel pens. My only issue with the book is that the designs are all pretty repetitive. If the paper weren't so heavy, a completed design could be used to wrap a small gift or make an origami figure, but the paper is too heavy for either of these things. Sometimes, repetition is nice; but my personal preference is to actually color a PICTURE that may ultimately be framed for display or a gift.
