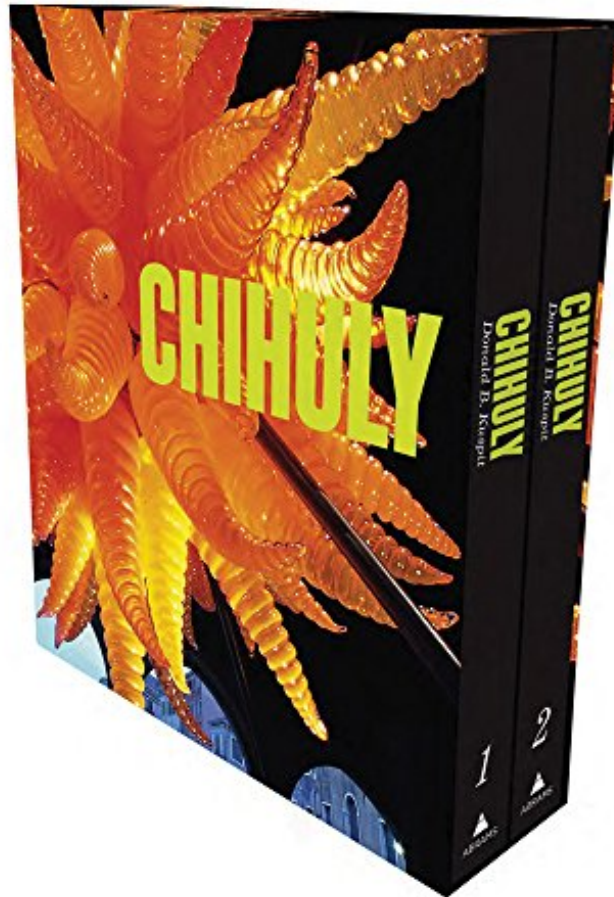

A magnificent addition to our collection of art books, plus a guaranteed attention-getter as a coffee-table book. Volume 1 is a new edition of the excellent, previously published single volume of the same name, by the same author. Volume 2 captures a cross-section of all the art that Dale Chihuly has created in the years since that first book came out. I should note that when we received ours, I discovered that two pages in Vol. 2 were joined together by an uncut bottom corner that had been folded to fit neatly within the profile of the other pages, all of which were properly trimmed. This slight defect was

remedied by the careful application of scissors and a ruler.
