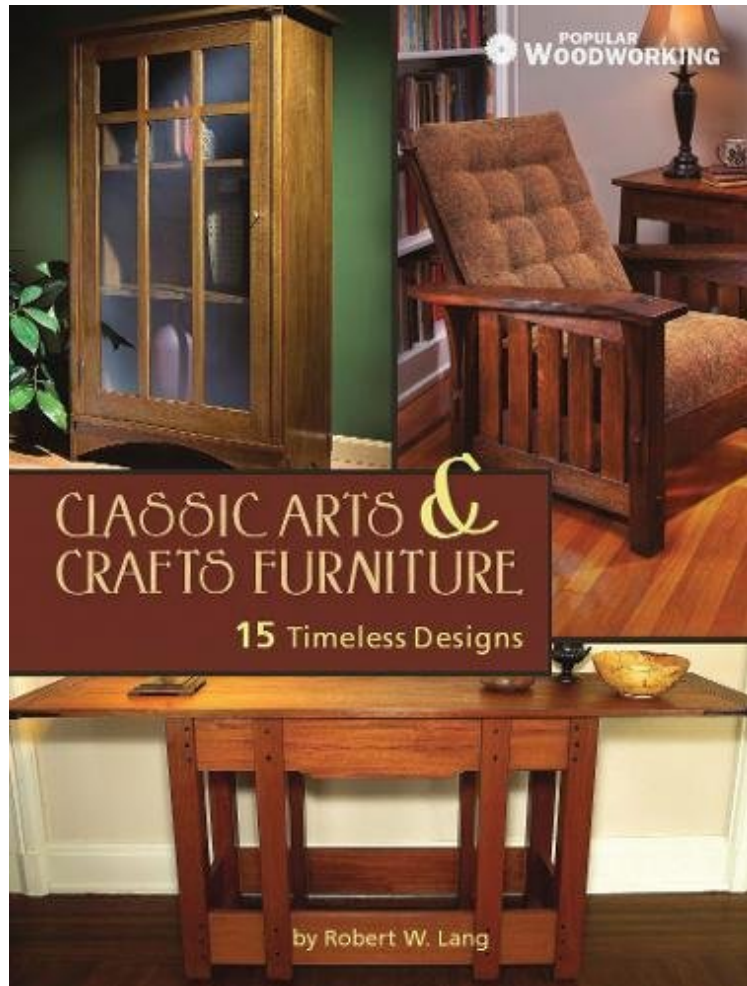

Stickley catalog and an original design from the author. I have been woodworking (Arts Craft Greene Greene furniture) for over 15 years and I have never been a big fan of P W Magazine projects. Detail assembly and sub-assembly diagrams are few and far between, case in point, the first project in the book is an A C buffet a design by the author, is eye appealing. The author provides on one page, two (2)

diagrams, a front and side elevation and a material list out of a total of eleven pages. The project is long on verbiage (some useful some not) and Mr. Lang's woodworking techniques.
