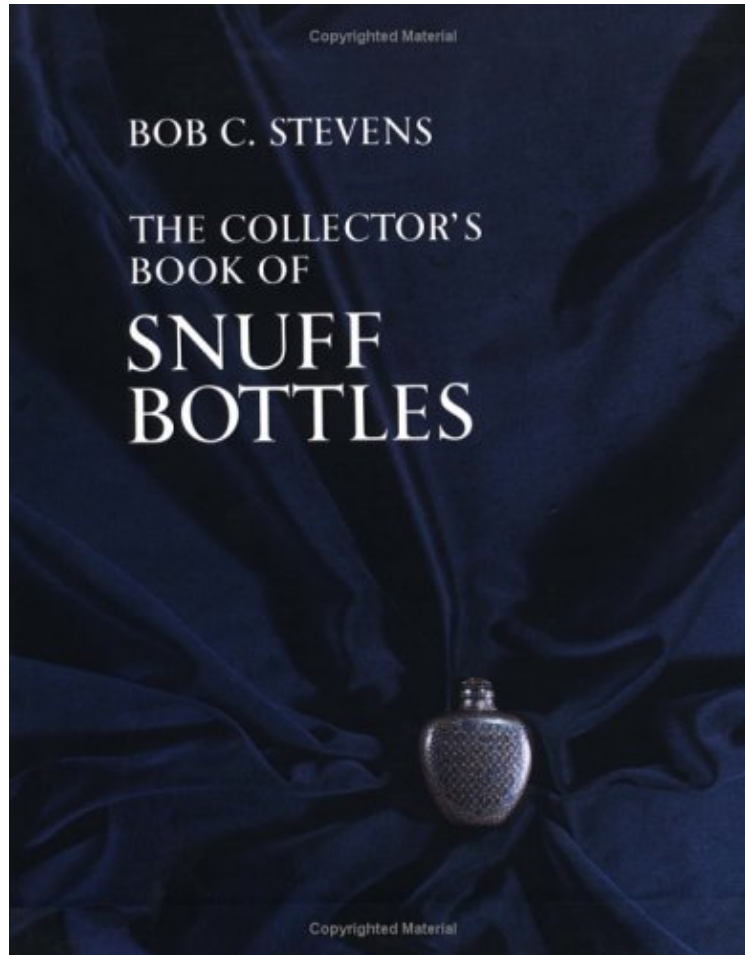

It is written by an authority who appears to be an elitist and obviously not down-to-earth enough to even consider collecting anything but antiques. There is nothing wrong with that attitude, but today, escalating prices of antique Chinese snuff bottles have put these out of reach of everyone except the ultra-rich. These same bottles were going for next to nothing fifty years ago. I know. I inherited some that are now worth tens of thousands of dollars. The mad craze of collecting have driven the prices out of the reach of most people. And yet, there are some modern day snuff bottle reproductions just as exquisite as those from palace workshops that deserve to be mentioned--instead to looked down on because they are not antique...My guess is that if it were mentioned that one could amass a decent snuff bottle collection without dropping a fortune, the door would be opened for the "riff-raff to enter the rarified world of snuff bottle collectors.
