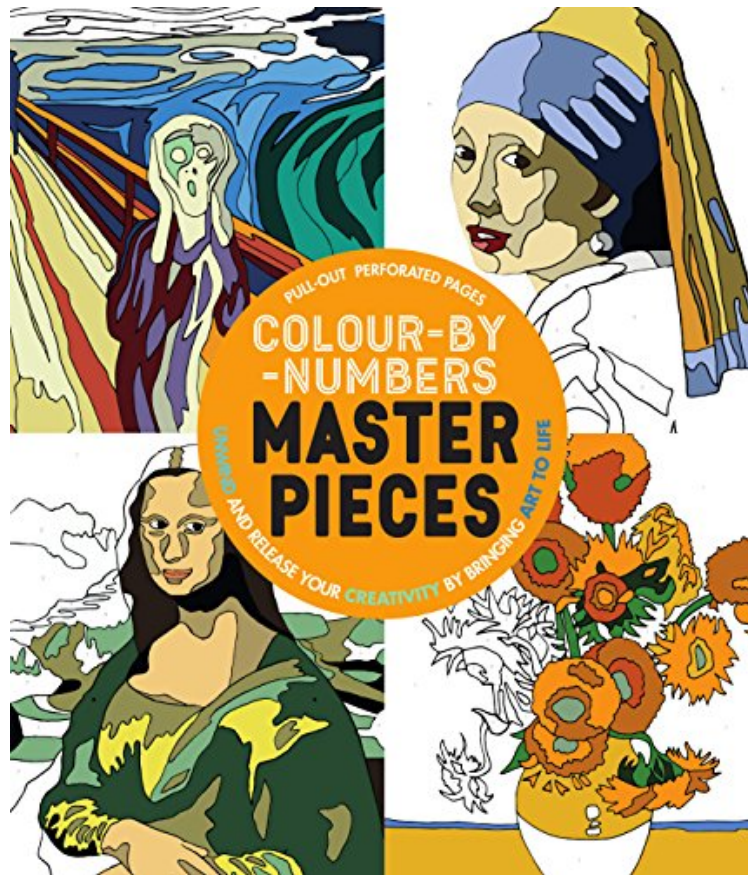

The pictures do not have as many colors - average ten, so the drawings do not take as long to complete. Because each drawing only has an average of ten colors each the drawing does not look as good as my other color-by-number book - Calm, by Chartwell Coloring or my color-by-number books from Creative Haven - Landscapes Flowers. The small color bars are sometimes hard to distinguish between navy, black or dark green for me. I wish the color name was printed under the color square.The spaces in the lines in this book are easier to see and color. But the numbers are very light. I need a magnifying glass to see the numbers. But then the numbers do not show through after being colored in. It. I like having a variety of designs to color so I am pleased with this book, but pictures would look more professional with an additional ten colors with extra shades and spaces to color.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
