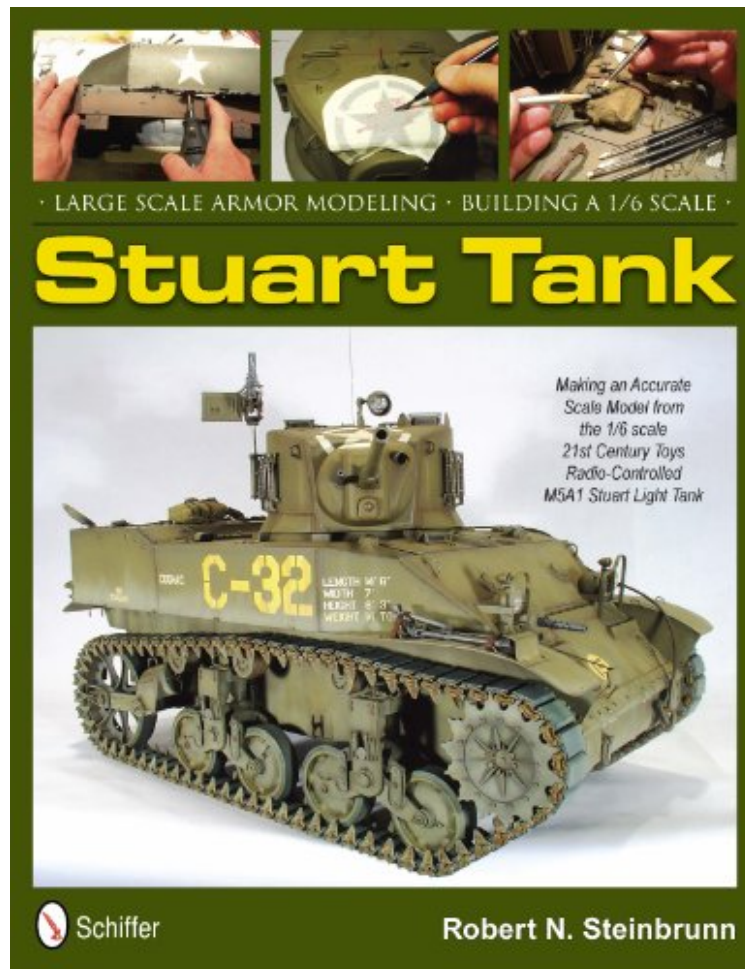

I thought this was going to be a tutorial along the lines of beginner to intermediate modeling skills. This book is way over the top/skill of the majority of us (my opinion)! The author has a major arsenal of experience and tooling/machining and a seemingly bottomless pocket book at his fingertips, the likes of which few of us have access to.
