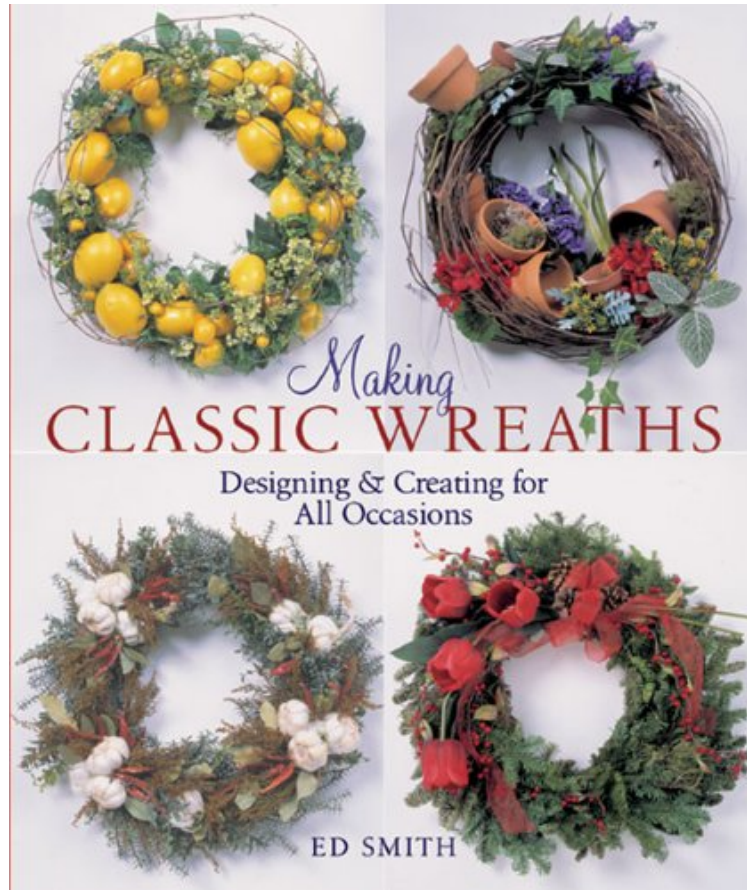

Author also included a supply list of different glues and their uses, paints types, wires, flower types, everything you would use making wreaths with helpful suggestions. The best one was the stemming machine, which I had never heard of. It makes and attaches the sharp, pointed, metal tips you find at the bottom of stems to insert the florals into the wreath. I checked around and they are over \$100 on and some other sites, but found them on eBay under a \$100. I highly recommend this book if you like making wreaths.
