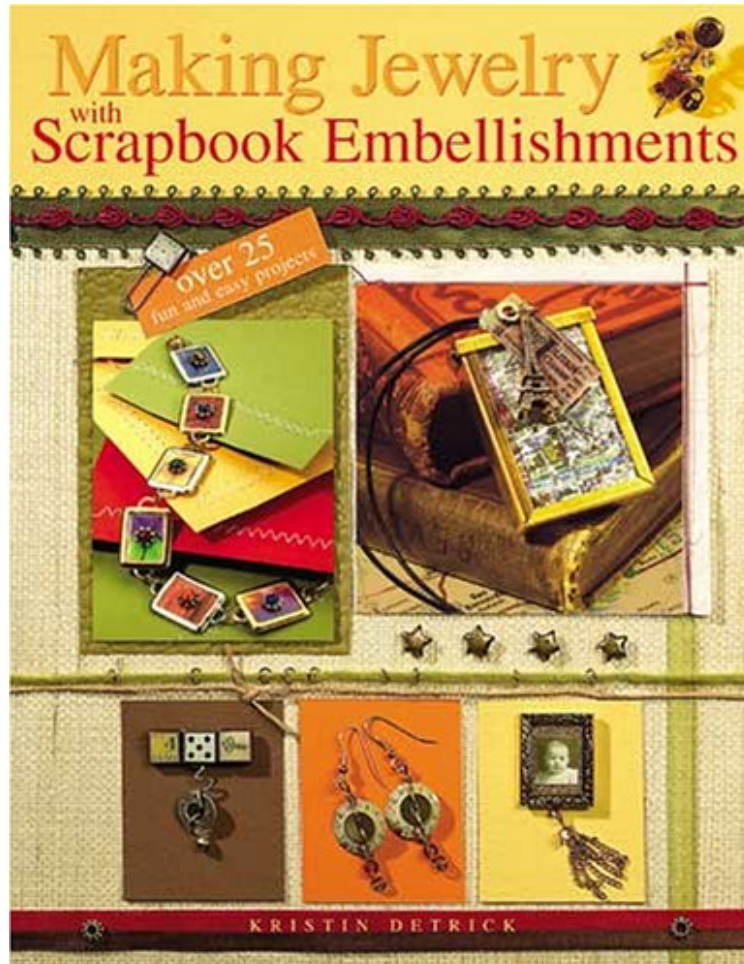

We have recently begun making jewelry for my wife's small shop and have tried our hands at several different styles, some

of which do fit with the projects found in this book. This is a very good for beginner level crafters as the project mostly involve modifying and assembling jewelry from existing embellishments. It starts by covering "Tools and Supplies", "Materials" and "Techniques", which seasoned jewelry makers may just want to skim through but will give beginner the foundation to tackle the included projects. The "Project" section includes over 20 projects that vary in complexity, but nothing too daunting. The instructions are good and often leave a bit of room for the user to modify and personalize to individual tastes. The accompanying photos are generally good, if occasionally a bit cluttered. Taken as listed, many of the projects really aren't "my style" but there are a lot of good ideas and techniques that can be leveraged in simplifying our production quality jewelry.
