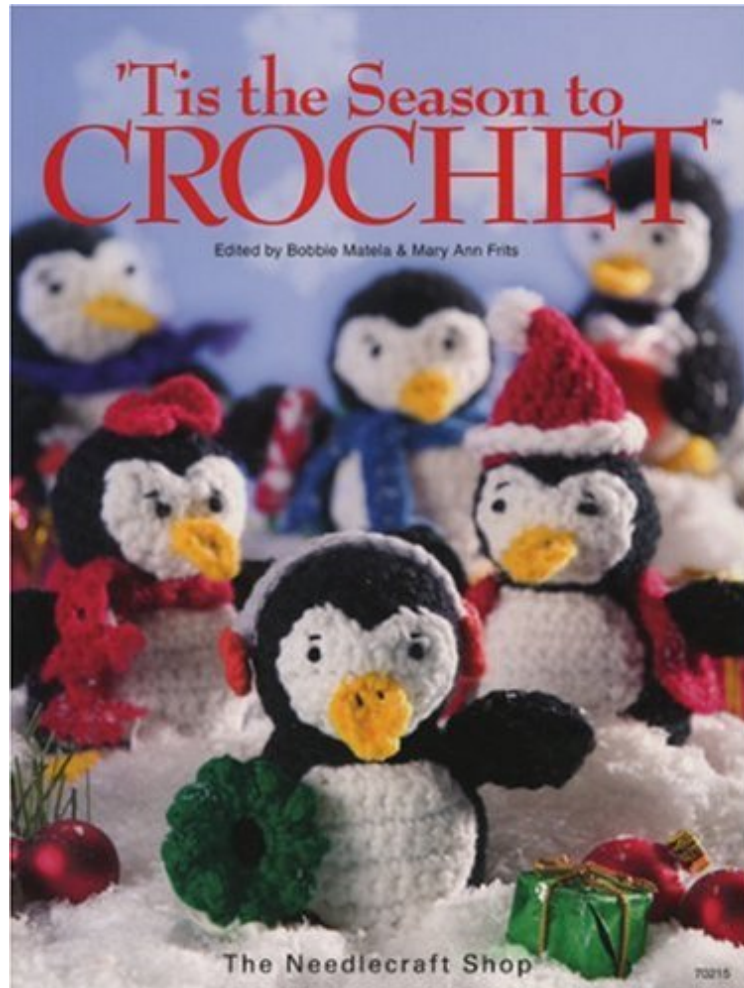

Perky Penguins (pictured on the cover): 4" high when finished, pattern outlines how to make the basic penguin body with the 8 variations of prop options
Christmas Ornament Trims: poinsettia bands for ball ornaments

Peppermint Candy Ornaments: includes three patterns: peppermint candy ornament, peppermint pinwheel ornament, peppermint spiral ornament
Santa Tree Shirt [personal

note, I'm not a Santa person (meaning I don't decorate with Santas very often) but this tree skirt is adorable]Christmas Wreath: crocheted with different textured yarn in a sheet, then sewed together around a foam wreathElf, Gingerbread Man and Snowman Shelf Sitters: 9" tall when seated, excluding legsNoel Stocking and Snowman StockingWhimsical Santa and Snowman OrnamentsChristmas Tree Table Topper: 14" high, 20" in diameter, includes patterns for little ornaments to go on the treeSnowman Trio: 15" tall, three patterns for free-standing "skinny" snowmen. I say skinny because they don't have ball-like bodies.
