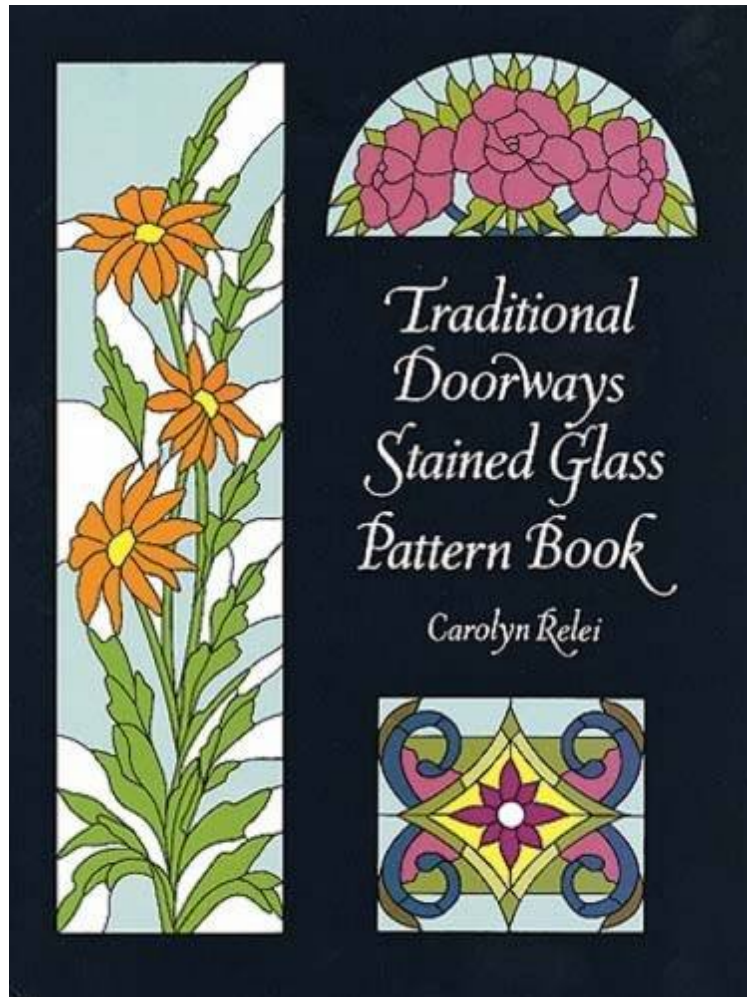

There are squares, rectangles, ovals, circles and half circles. Many are floral, some geometric, few are colorized, but the designs are easy to select colors for. They are suited for doorways, transoms, sidelights and window panels. Stained glass windows are a treasure to see, they draw

us in when illuminated and seem to glow with the sunlight. This Dover publication is a nice addition to a stained glass book collection.

Through the centuries, the rich tones and lovely designs of stained glass art have enhanced the doorways and entries of countless buildings, providing a welcoming aura of beauty and light. The appealing and highly inviting patterns in this splendid sourcebook make it easy for craftspeople to create 163 traditional motifs, ideal for use in sidelights, fanlights, transoms, and other doorway configurations. Based on authentic originals, the attractive designs feature a dazzling array of subjects, including geometric configurations, florals and foliates in curvilinear presentations, and more. (A magnificent peacock, in a fan-shaped format, is especially spectacular.) Reminiscent of exquisite Victorian and Art Nouveau designs, these lovely patterns come in a number of useful shapes: rectangles, squares, circles, semi-circles, and ovals. Artists, artisans, and craftspeople looking for patterns that evoke the charm of a bygone era will find that these attractive copyright-free stained glass designs lend themselves equally well to a host of other art and craft projects.
