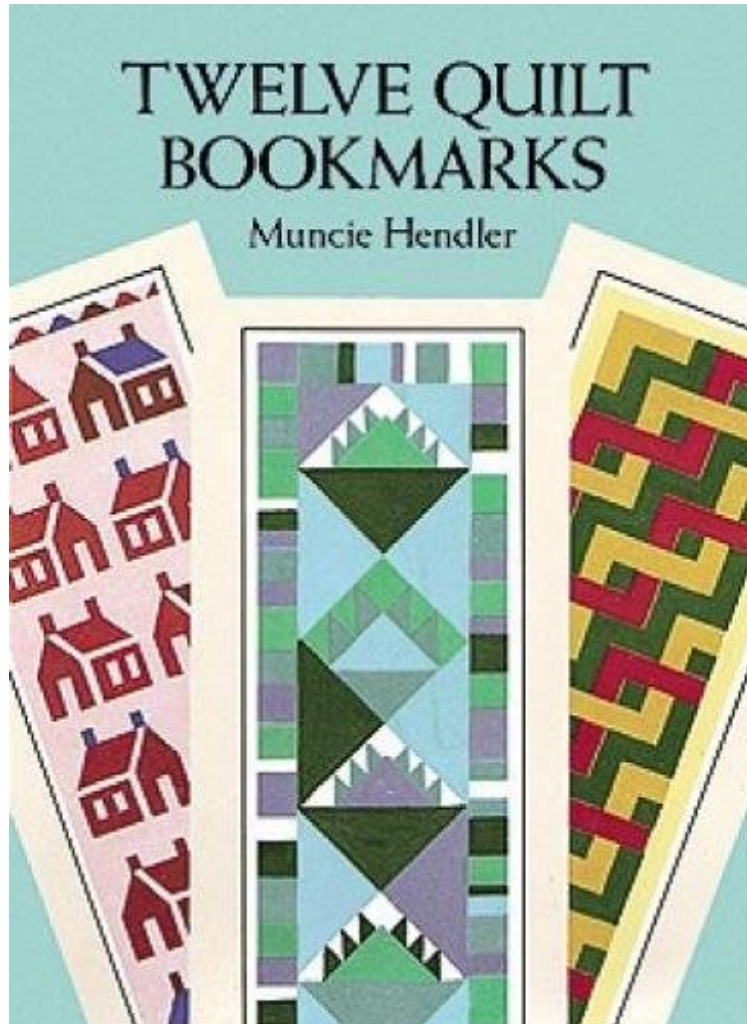

Indeed, most designs are shapely patterns (unlike the house quilt on the cover). I'm extremely pleased with these bookmarks. While you do have to rip them out and separate them yourself, it wasn't a hassle if you took your time. By pomplemousse I was a little surprised at this set of bookmarks because I was expecting a packet of separated bookmarks with quilt pictures. That isn't what I got--it's actually a booklet (like the Hawaiian quilt stickers on here--I think it's the same company) with 2 bookmarks per page that have perforations for you to separate. They work as bookmarks and the printing itself is fine, I just wasn't expecting it. So, I suppose you could keep it as a book of quilt patterns if you wanted to (without the instructions). Not bad, and not expensive. Bought it for my mom, who is a wonderful quilter and loves to read.

Probably no type of folk art is considered more typically American than the patchwork quilt. These handmade masterpieces have come to be considered works of art, and quilts, both modern and antique, are now highly prized collector's items.
