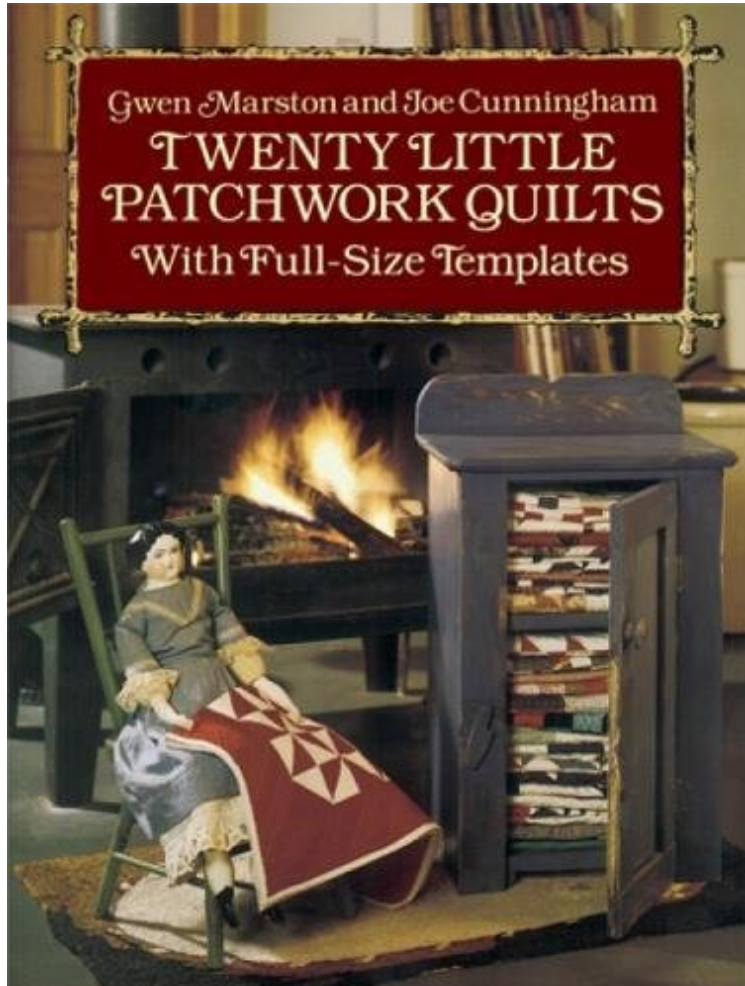

Directions are clear and easy to follow. I stapled an envelope to the inside of the book, cut out the cardstock patterns and stored them in the envelope. These little quilts are a great way for a "newbie" to practice, or to have fun with color studies, as the author suggests. They
