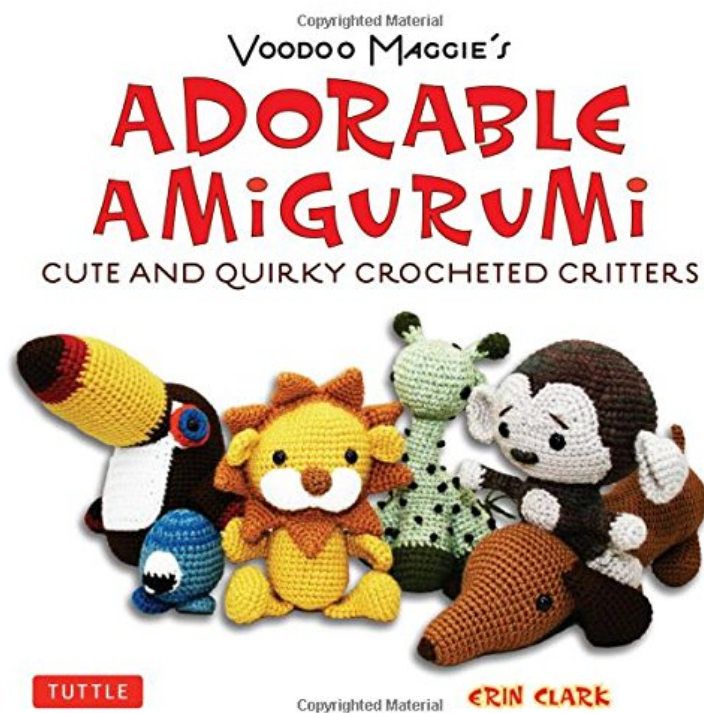

Yes, they are cute! However, the pattern instructions are miserable. Patterns use non-standard abbreviations. There are no graphs, even where they would be highly useful. Photos of pieces of works in progress are included, but sometimes inserted in the wrong spot within the written directions. Materials lists are inaccurate and incomplete. The instructions include weird methods that make things way more complex than they need to be. For the experienced amigurumi-maker, you'll be able to muddle through and with a bit of trial and error, you can successfully complete the projects. However, if you are new to amigurumi this is NOT the book to start with.
