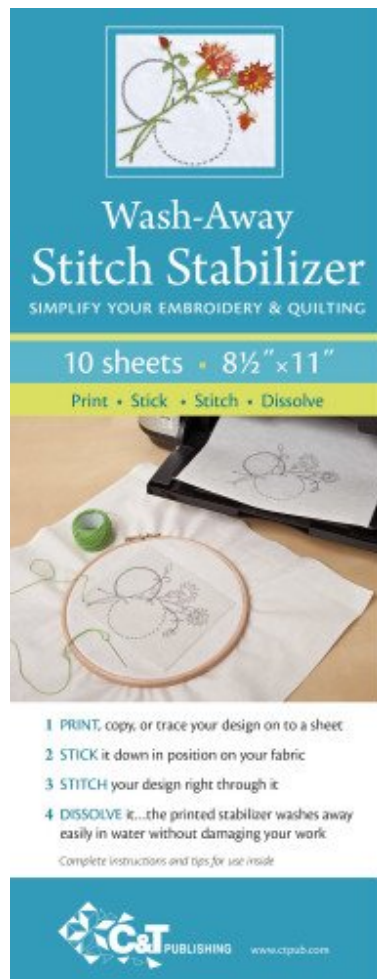

But it isn't an issue if you use an emery bag to clean it periodically. I love the way it washes completely out using warm water. I've tried using several kinds of pens to transfer my own artwork onto the stabilizer. The Pigma Micron work great and wash out completely leaving no trace of color behind. Pilot G-2 bleeds! Using contrasting colored ink from the thread color works perfectly. Great for dark fabrics.
